Who: All children ages 4 1/2 - 18
(born between August 1, 1991 and January 31, 2006)

(Proof of age, i.e. birth certificate, is required for all children that did not play in Region 638 in 2009. In addition, if a player did not play in Region 638 in 2009 and will be 8 years of age or older before August 1, 2010 they will need to be present for a skills test in order for registration to be completed)

Applications for the 2010 Season can be completed online at www.eayso.org and is highly recommended for both players and volunteers (see instructions on reverse) to help speed up the registration process. Once an online player application is completed, please print **one copy on a single sheet of clean, white paper (double-sided)** and bring it to one of the registration events listed above. An online application does not register your child/children in our region. Registration can only be completed in person. For those applying to Coach or Referee, you will receive special fast service through the registration process (see complete details on the reverse)!

2010 Registration Fees:

Extra Early Registration Fee (valid March 13th & May 1st): \$85 per child

Early Registration Fee (valid June 19th): \$100 per child

Regular Registration Fee (beginning after June 19th): \$120 per child

Includes uniform (shirt, shorts, and socks), pictures, and trophy.

Practices for the Fall 2010 Season will begin the week of August 23rd for the U6-U14 Divisions and games will held on Saturdays, beginning September 11th. Practice and game locations for each division vary and include, but are not limited to Lane Park, Joe Walker, Hillview, Valley View, Esperanza, and Marie Kerr Park. This year there may be some travel games for the U12 and U14 Divisions to other Regions (i.e. Rosamond). U16-U19 Divisions will have an accelerated season to conform to CIF regulations; practices for these divisions will begin the week of August 2nd and games will begin August 14th. Some U16-U19 games may be played out of the area and on some weeknights, Saturdays, and Sundays. Practices may be held at any of the locations listed above.

At a time and place convenient for you, you can provide all the information you normally have to write by hand on an application form - just visit www.eayso.org and follow the online instructions - it is as easy as that. Online applications are available for both players and volunteers!

Players: **Print out ONE copy of each players form on a single sheet of plain white paper (doubled-sided)**, sign, initial, and date it, and bring it to one of our registration dates listed on the reverse. Remember, proof of age, i.e. birth certificate, is required for all children that did not play in Region 638 in 2009. In addition, if a player did not play in Region 638 in 2009 and will be 8 years of age or older before August 1, 2010 they will need to be present for a skills test in order for registration to be completed

Volunteers: **Print out TWO copies, each on a single sheet of plain white paper (doubled-sided)**, sign and date it, and bring it to one of our registration dates listed on the reverse along with a valid ID.

FAST PASS LINE FOR COACHES AND REFEREES

All those volunteering to coach or referee will be eligible to use the Fast Pass Line. Each volunteer must present the following before being allowed to enter:

- **ONE copy of the online player application (on a single sheet of plain white paper, double-sided) for each player being registered**; Remember, proof of age, i.e. birth certificate, is required for all children that did not play in Region 638 in 2009. In addition, if a player did not play in Region 638 in 2009 and will be 8 years of age or older before August 1, 2010 they will need to be present for a skills test in order for registration to be completed
- **TWO copies of the online volunteer application**, each form on a single sheet of plain white paper (doubled-sided)
- A valid ID
- If volunteering to Coach: a completed Coach Information Form (available at www.qhayso.org under forms)
- If volunteering to be a Referee: a completed Referee Information Form (available at www.qhayso.org under forms)

PLEASE NOTE: If a coach/referee does not have all of the above items, they will not be allowed to use the Fast Pass line but rather will be directed to the end of the regular registration line. No exceptions.

All VIP Players may also use the Fast Pass Line (online player application must be completed, printed and presented at the door)
